
NORFOLK WAR MEMORIALS PROJECT

PART III: 1939 – 1945

The two previous issues of this Journal have contained articles on the local memorials from the First World War. This note summarises what is known about the local men who served and died in the Second World War.

Although the Second World War is still within living memory it is rarely the case now that local knowledge can supply details of the war service and death of those named on village war memorials. Some families move away and others do not have the information, so local knowledge still has to be supplemented by documentary research. The table shows the information that has been found for three villages: Blakeney, Letheringsett and Wiveton. As yet very little is known about the nine names from Cley so these have been excluded from the table, but they are shown below in case any reader can help:



The award of the DFC to Nicholas Gresham Cooke is a clear recognition of his bravery in action. Yet many acts of courage and self-sacrifice went unrewarded, perhaps known only to those few present at the time. Raymond Harcourt's death is a reminder of this. After the war a friend of his contacted the Harcourt family to say that they had both found themselves in the sea after their ship had been sunk on the way to Japan. The two shared the support of a haversack until it became water-logged at which point Raymond let go and was drowned – his friend survived.
